

Matthew 5:44-48 ⁴³ "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.¹ ⁴⁴ But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, ⁴⁵ so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven.
