

John 7:45-52 Session 15B

John 7:45-49 ⁴⁵ The officers then came to the chief priests and Pharisees, who said to them, "Why did you not bring him?" 46 The officers answered, "No one ever spoke like this man!" ⁴⁷ The Pharisees answered them, "Have you also been deceived? 48 Have any of the authorities or the Pharisees believed in him? ⁴⁹ But this crowd that does not know the law is accursed."

- Were the Temple guards incompetent?
- What becomes clear with the Pharisees comment about the crowd?

John 7:50-52 ⁵⁰ Nicodemus, who had gone to him before, and who was one of them, said to them, ⁵¹ "Does our law judge a man without first giving him a hearing and learning what he does?" ⁵² They replied, "Are you from Galilee too? Search and see that no prophet arises from Galilee."

- What was the tactic of the Jewish leaders to both the Temple police and Nicodemus?
- Did any prophet ever come from Galilee?
- What is the basis of unbelief?
